



POTTED HALLOWEEN TREATS

Using your favorite Halloween pattern, trace it onto tracing paper with pencil. Place tracing paper with pattern on terra cotta pot in desired location and using sharpie marker follow tracing. The ink will transfer the pattern to your piece. Several shapes can be utilized depending on the size of your pot and desired placement. Pattern can be placed on the "side" of the pot or on its rim.

After tracing begin painting with desired Concepts color. When desired color is opaque-use three coats, and when desired color is translucent use one coat.

Paint entire piece as desired.

This picture has three coats of black on the rim. The "foot" was created by using a terra cotta saucer turned upside down. It is "glued" together utilizing French Dimensions as glue before firing.

Dry thoroughly.

Apply clear glaze as desired-it can be sponged on top of areas for a shiny surface. Remember to glaze the inside of the pot with food safe glaze.
